**Qualifying Marks in the MSc Entrance Examination for candidates for eligibility for admission**


Please note: "The 'Qualifying Marks in the Entrance Examinations' are the minimum marks required to be eligible for admission to the Course. However, in all Courses wherein admissions are based on the rank/merit in the entrance examination, securing the Qualifying Marks in the Entrance Examinations is not a guarantee for admission, but merely an entitlement to be considered for admission. Admission to such Courses shall depend upon the availability of seats in the course, and the rank of candidate in the merit list, and other requirements as notified in the Bulletin of Information."

For example, if 20 candidates score marks above qualifying criteria in entrance exam in a particular category (Gen/OBC/etc) and there are 3 seats available for admission in that category on basis of entrance exam, then the first offer of admissions will be given to top 3 candidates scoring the highest marks in entrance exam among the 20 candidates in that category. If any seats remain unfilled, the offer of admission will be given to next candidate accordingly.

1. To be eligible for admission to MSc program in Department of Microbiology for academic year 2017-18 on basis of entrance test, the minimum qualifying criteria as decided by department admission committee, are as follows:

Qualifying criteria	General	OBC	SC/ST
Marks in entrance exam	40 % marks (160 out of 400 marks)	36% marks (144 out of 400 marks)	28% marks (112 out of 400 marks)
Qualifying criteria	PwD+Gen, CW+Gen	PwD+OBC, CW+OBC	PwD +SC/ST, CW+SC/ST
Marks in entrance exam	38 % marks (152 out of 400 marks)	34.2% marks (137 out of 400 marks)	26.6% marks (107 out of 400 marks)

2. For the candidates applying under CW & PwD category, the qualifying criteria would be as per their reservation category (Gen/OBC/SC/ST) with 5% relaxation. For example if a candidate belongs to CW+OBC category, the qualifying criteria for that candidate will be 5% less than that for OBC category. If such candidate qualifies the criteria for his/her reservation category, then admission will be offered to candidate against supernumerary seat. If there are more than one candidate in CW or PwD category, a single merit list of all CW candidates (whether Gen/SC/ST/OBC) and single merit list of all PwD candidates (whether Gen/SC/ST/OBC) who have qualified will be prepared based on their marks in entrance test. There will be maximum of 1 supernumerary seat each for CW and PwD candidates, if eligible.
