Notice regarding interviews for admission to PhD program in Microbiology

All the applicants who have applied for admission to PhD program in Department of Microbiology in Phase I for academic year 2023-24 are hereby informed that the interviews will be held on 30-31 August 2023. The interviews will held in physical mode only in the Department as per following schedule:

- 1. Applicants with first names starting from alphabet A to N reporting time 9:30 AM on 30-August
- 2. Applicants with first names starting from alphabet P to Z reporting time 9:30 AM on 31-August

Please note that only those applicants will be interviewed who fulfill the criteria for eligibility for directly appearing in the interview as specified below. Applicants are required to bring evidence of their eligibility along with their educational qualification certificates, copies of their CV, dissertation, and research publications (if any).

Eligibility criteria:

1. Minimum 55% marks (or equivalent CGPA) in Post graduate degree in any branch of life science from a recognized University/ institute (relaxation of 5% marks for applicants belonging to SC/ST/OBC-NCL, PwD categories)

2. UGC-CSIR-NET-LS, or UGC-CSIR-NET-JRF, or GATE qualified, or DBT-JRF, or ICMR-JRF, or ICAR-NET, or DST-INSPIRE fellowship, or qualified equivalent national level examination/ fellowship as per Ordinance VI of University of Delhi.

Important:

Those applying in OBC-NCL or EWS categories must have NCL eligibility certificates for the financial year 2022-23, which has been issued on or after <u>01-Apr-2023</u>. The OBC applicants who belong to Non-creamy layer and whose caste appears in the central list of the OBCs only shall be eligible to be considered for admission under OBC category. Any applicant who has applied under OBC-NCL or EWS categories, and who does not have a valid certificate or are found ineligible for the category, will not be considered under OBC-NCL/ EWS categories. Such applicants will then be considered under the UR category only.

Area of Research:

The applicants may be asked to specify their preference for the broad area in which they wish to pursue PhD research. The details of research topics along with names of lab in which seats are available will be shared with all applicants through their registered email before date of interview. The applicants are therefore advised to monitor their emails for any communication from the Department.
